Spring Greetings to our MW Alliance Foundation Members,



These are the people who saw the need for social interaction, of helping, and in giving back to others - what we now call "community."


And just maybe, they created the foundation for why, today, Manitowish Waters is undeniably the "gem" of the Northwoods.






























































Special thanks to the **Manitowish Waters Historical Society** for providing the annual Chamber of Commerce "Visitors Guide" cover photos.

Nearly every part of our lives have been upended since March of 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Here we are - one year later. We live differently. We play differently. We work differently. And along with the community organizations we support; we at the MW Alliance Foundation are also striving to create, reimagine, and alter our programs and services so we can optimize our efforts to achieve outstanding results. Here are just a few of the ways we've been able to accomplish that:

- With the merger of the MW Community
 Foundation and the MW Alliance, we have been a
 not-for-profit Foundation for one year! Thank you
 to everyone that, for the first time ever, were able
 to make tax-deductible donations to the Alliance
 in support of MANI*WISH or the local
 organization of their choice, or to honor the
 memory of a loved-one. Your generosity makes a
 big difference in our small community.
- Launched our first ever online auction site last November in support of our "2nd Annual MANI*WISH Christmas" fundraising event. We exceeded our goal of raising \$10,000 for needy children and families by tallying more than \$14,000 in donations.
- With the success of MANI*WISH Christmas, in February we began a slow roll-out of the *new*, *year-round* "MANI*WISH Giving Program" to meet the rising requests for financial relief from community residents facing a specific need. At the end of the day, we saw over 100 people participate and we raised a record \$6,000 from raffles baskets and Live Auctions - making this the most successful money raising social on record!
